

Airman Third Class Haugh was a member of the 1818th Airways and Air Communication System Group, U.S. Air Force.

On November 15, 1952, he was a passenger on a C-46D Commando transport from the 34th Troop Carrier Squadron, 315th Troop Carrier Wing. The aircraft was transporting personnel from Kangnung Airfield (K-18) to Pohang Airfield (K-3). It crashed into the Sea of Japan shortly after takeoff killing ten on board.

His remains were not recovered.
