

PFC Leland E Belgard

His next of kin was noted as Mrs. Elsie I. Belgard who resided in Fairfax, VA.

Leland served as a Private First Class, 417th Infantry Regiment, 76th Infantry Division, U.S. Army during World War II.

He resided in Penobscot County, Maine prior to the war.

He was previously a member of the National Guard. He re-enlisted in the Army on October 27, 1941, prior to the war, at Camp Blanding, Florida. He was noted, at the time of his enlistment, as being employed as a Farm Hand and also as Single, without dependents.

Leland was "**Killed In Action**" during the war and was awarded the Purple Heart.
